Arizona Youth Leadership Forum (AZYLF) is an innovative multi-day conference that empowers youth and young adults who have disabilities and other diversities as they navigate the transition to adulthood.

AZYLF is peer led, with young adults serving as facilitators and peer leaders throughout the conference. Participants explore leadership, the disability experience, goal setting, community resources, and self-advocacy in an engaging environment with other young people.

To be eligible, youth must meet the following requirements:

- Identify as having a disability
- Identify as being part of the LGBTQ+ community
- Be in high school or be a young adult under the age of 26
- Wish to increase personal leadership, self-reliance, and self-advocacy skills
- Approach this opportunity with enthusiasm and commitment
- Live in Arizona

This is a daytime conference, with no overnight stay. No lodging is provided.

Lunch, snacks, and beverages are provided each day.

Participation is free.
