The Engaging Families and Young Adults Program offers opportunities for young adults and families who have various backgrounds and life experiences to meaningfully engage with the organizations and systems impacting them and their communities.

1. Family and Young Adult Advisors

Family and Young Adult Advisors are family members or young adults (ages 18 to 26) who wish to represent the communities they identify with. This group includes individuals who have disabilities, ongoing healthcare needs, and various backgrounds and experiences.

2. Receive Training

Diverse Ability Incorporated and Encircle Families provide Family and Young Adult Advisors with initial training and ongoing support for the Engaging Families and Young Adults Program.

3. Placement Agency

Following training, Diverse Ability Incorporated and Encircle Families match Advisors with organizations, known as placement agencies, seeking their expertise. Advisor involvement with placement agencies is personalized and can change over time.

4. Meaningful Impact

Connecting Advisors with firsthand experience to placement agencies that design and implement initiatives for their well-being creates change and promotes optimal health for all. Placement agencies value the insights of Advisors and compensate them for their contributions.
