- Experienced in navigating the various systems to access necessary daily services
- Can provide valuable insight and feedback to shape the resources and services provided by Pinal County Public Health.

How the Young Adult Advisor will engage with Pinal County Public Health:

- Attend Community Health team meetings to learn about Public Health services and population health initiatives. Provide real-time feedback and suggestions.
- Review services and identify gaps or opportunities for improvement of services or resources for families, children, and young adults, including those with special healthcare needs.
- Complete independent work outside of meeting times; communicate consistently through email correspondence.

Must have reliable transportation, a laptop with internet and email access, and be available for 1–2 meetings per month, with independent work between meetings.
Compensation: \$25/hour for *up to* 12 hours per month, including independent work.
